On June 12, 2018 the Summit County Board of Commissioners imposed Stage I fire restrictions for all areas of unincorporated Summit County. To ensure that our restrictions are compatible, and to reduce confusion for citizens and visitors of our area, and because of recent fire activity and local response resource limitations, I am at this time ordering the following Fire Restrictions for the Town of Blue River:

1. Open Burning Ban, defined as the prohibited use of any outside fire, including camp fires and warming fires. This excludes fires in permanently constructed fire rings within the city's RV and Camping Parks, and charcoal grills, and wood burning fire places, (chiminea) or fire pits with proper fitting screen covers and 25' separation of flammable materials at private residences.

These restrictions do not apply to gas-fueled grills used out-of-doors, or to fires within liquid-fueled or gas-fueled stoves.

If weather patterns change the local outlook significantly one way or the other, Fire Restrictions will be adjusted accordingly.
